

Statement of Responsibility: Any manager, coach, league official, or tournament director participating in TTAB-TTAS sponsored programs who drinks or allows the drinking of alcoholic beverages, or who uses abusive or profane language, either in person or by telephone, or makes any attempt to commit or does bodily harm to any officer, director, representative or umpire of TTAB-TTAS shall be suspended immediately from further participation in any TTAB-TTAS sponsored activity for any number of years up to a lifetime ban.

Any fan or parent of a player participating in TTAB-TTAS guilty of any of the above infractions will be reported to their local league president for disciplinary action.

CLIFTON, MERIDIAN, VALLEY MILLS, BOSQUEVILLE Local Rules adjunct to TTAB, TTAS and ASA Rules

THESE RULES MUST BE POSTED IN ALL CONCESSION STANDS AND PROVIDED TO ALL MANAGERS AND COACHES.

1. T-Ball run rules will be according to the TTAB rulebook, except no inning will start after 1 hour and 15 minutes of play.
2. Games involving Junior Midget Baseball will have a 5 run rule for the first three innings, then unlimited. No inning will start after 1 hour and 30 minutes of play.
3. Midget Softball will have a 5 run rule for the first three innings, then unlimited. No inning will start after 1 hour and 45 minutes of play.
4. Senior Midget and above will play run limits per the TTAB rules. Senior Midget time is 1 hour and 45 minutes. All other baseball games have a 2-hour time limit. Time limits for softball are per the TTAS rulebook.
5. A legal game can be played with 8 players (the ninth batter is an automatic out.)
6. If a team does not have 8 players, a 15 minute grace period will be allowed before forfeit is called.
7. Any requests for rescheduling of games requires approval of the county board with proper notice. Failure to give proper notification can result in a forfeit. Makeup games should be played as soon as possible.
8. League champions are determined by season records where schedules are essentially the same, such as in most ages 12 and under. For older age groups, the season record applies to common foes. In the case of a tie in the overall record, the first tiebreaker will be head to head game record. If there is still a tie, then a single game playoff will be held. Champions must be determined from at least a ten game record.
9. Umpires must be at least 16 years of age.
10. Each team will be allowed one reschedule throughout the season for a reason other than school functions once the final schedule is prepared.

Please realize the local rules are intended to make play fair to all players and teams. This does not affect tournament play. Time limits are necessary because there are games to follow. Please clarify any confusion prior to the first pitch – after that the umpire is in charge.
